#### About the speakers



#### **Professor Raymond Vanholder**

Prof. Vanholder is a retired nephrologist (Prof. Em at Ghent University) who has published more than 900 papers, including reviews and book chapters on adequacy of dialysis, uremic toxicity and various topics related to clinical nephrology. Prof. Vanholder is the founding president of the Belgian Society of Nephrology (BVN-SBN), and past president of the European Society of Artificial Organs (ESAO) and of the European Renal Association (ERA). He is now chair of the European Kidney Health Alliance and the European Chronic Disease Alliance.

Until autumn 2010, he was chairman of the European Uremic Toxin Work Group (EUTox) and member of the Executive Board and treasurer of Kidney Disease Improving Global Outcomes (KDIGO). Until summer 2011 he was chairman of the European Renal Best Practice (ERBP). Until autumn 2014, he chaired the Renal Disaster Relief Task Force (RDRTF) of the International Society of Nephrology (ISN) and participated in several international relief operations



#### **Eveline Scheres - MBA**

Eveline Scheres is an expert in (health) innovation, strategy, public affairs and advocacy. She has 20+ years working experience mostly in the Health Environment. She was the head of Public Affairs and Strategy at the Dutch Cancer Society between 2012-2020. She also was the initiator and first chair of the Access to Medicine Task Force of the European Cancer Leagues (ECL), an oncology platform of 25 cancer fighting NGO's. She also co-authored a White Paper on Tackling Challenges in Access to Medicines for All Cancer Patients in Europe (October 2018). These collaborative efforts led to the adoption of 'the beating cancer plan' by the European Commission.

Eveline Scheres started at EKHA in 2020 as a Transition Manager and is now General Manager. In this role she also is a coauthor to one publication and several position statements and open letters together with Professor Raymond Vanholder.
