However, 97% of healthcare expenditure in Europe is currently spent on treatment and only 3% on prevention. Additionally, the health literacy of the population is still very low, while it is a cornerstone to prevent diseases.

Thus, there is an urgent need for **improving public awareness and education** on diseases and for **enhancing a political shift from intervention to prevention**.
